

Underlay fitting guidelines




A Ensure that the subfloor is reasonably level, sound, dry and free from dust, grease or other contaminants.

Timber Floors: Nail loose floorboards down and hammer all protruding nails flush.


Concrete: Fill any deep gaps and sand all protruding lumps down.




B Whisper underlay can be laid either side up but must be laid at right angles to any existing floorboards. When installing **Whisper** underlay allow for a 5cm excess to run up the walls.



C All edges of the **Whisper** underlay should be closely butted up against the adjoining roll and the overlap securely taped using a single-sided waterproof tape. This should then form a moisture-resistant sub-floor ready for the desired flooring to be fitted.



D Once the laminate or wood flooring has been laid, the 5cm excess **Whisper** underlay around the perimeter can then be trimmed flush with the flooring. The perimeter of the room can then be finished with skirting, scotia, etc.
